MINUTES:

Todd Armstrong made a motion to approve his registration. The motion failed.

Roger Pearson made a motion to deny his registration. The motion carried with two opposed.

OLD BUSINESS:

Polygraph Training:

The change in the training requirement for Polygraph Examiners took effect immediately upon inception.

Rule 3.25:

All commissioned security officers shall carry their weapons only on their assigned site in the performance of their duties. The carrying of a weapon will be prohibited if the commissioned security officer is not performing his/her duties.

Mike Vowell made a motion adopt Rule 3.25. The motion was seconded by Todd Armstrong and carried with two opposed.
