**NEW BUSINESS:**

**Polygraph Examiner Renewal Application:  
Statement Regarding Polygraph Training Every 3 Years**

**Polygraph Examiners are required to submit 14 hours of continuing education every 2 years. This change went into effect in February 2007.**

**Gary Harp made a motion to have the Polygraph Examiner Renewal Application amended to include the following statement regarding training: Submit proof of 14 hours of continuing education units obtained in the past 2 years if not on file. This was seconded by Joey Page and carried unanimously.**

**Employee, Alarm Employee, and Owner/Manager Renewal Application:  
Statement for Listing Any Arrest, Conviction, Etc.**

**Jordon Brown made a motion to amend the above renewal applications to have the statement regarding arrests etc. to read: The applicant must list all convictions of a felony, class "a" misdemeanor, crime involving an act of violence or moral turpitude, if the applicant has been convicted, he or she must attach documentation certified by the court as to the disposition of the charge. The applicant must also list any criminal charges now pending or on appeal. This motion was seconded by Joey Page and carried unanimously.**
