CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman, Jordon Brown, called the meeting to order at 10:01 a.m.

RECOGNITION OF THE NEWS MEDIA:

Senior Corporal Ricky Briggs, Board Administrator, confirmed notification of the news media in regard to this meeting.

MINUTES:

Jordon Brown asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the last meeting held on October 12, 2011. James Shourd made a motion to approve the minutes. This motion was seconded by Jess Odom and carried unanimously.

HEARINGS:

CENTRAL DEFENSE SECURITY (CI 11 043) Mr. Larry Carroll, registered manager, testified.

Ralph Sims made a motion to assess a \$250 fine against the company. This motion was seconded by David Orsborn and carried unanimously.

AARON D. SLATER (BG 2008 0647) Mr. Slater testified. Johnny Standifer, registered manager, testified.

Mr. Slater's application was previously denied by the Board on February 9, 2011. He had his record sealed after his previous application was denied and appeared before the Board to request a registration. Jack Acre made a motion to approve his application. This motion was seconded by Ralph Sims and carried unanimously.

DANNY W. EDWARDS (BG 2011 0497) Mr. Edwards testified. Kathy Welch, with Arcom Systems, Inc., testified. Roger D. Chosen, Jr. with United Fire Suppression, testified.

David Orsborn made a motion to approve his registration, find him guilty of 17-40-350 (A) (5), and assess a \$250 fine. This motion was seconded by Jack Acre and carried with one opposed.

NEW BUSINESS:

Lt. Lindsey Williams:

Lt. Lindsey Williams addressed the Board regarding revising the forms and providing the state Board examinations electronically, along with his desire to incorporate this into the new licensing system.

Meredith Rebsamen:

Meredith Rebsamen, the Board's attorney, addressed the Board regarding the Notice of Violation. She presented an Informal Resolution. She requested that the Board adopt the Informal Resolution.

There was discussion of the statute that gives the administrator authority as granted by the law. The Board addressed their concerns with suggested changes to the Notice of Violation presented by the Board's attorney. The Board suggested the addition of one line to the current notice, but not a complete change or revision of the current format.

Jess Odom made a motion to postpone further discussion on the Notice of Violation. This motion was seconded by Ralph Sims and carried unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

APX Alarm Security Solutions, Inc./Vivint, Inc.:

Sr. Cpl. Briggs advised the Board that two checks were received in settlement of the APX Alarm Security Solutions, Inc., now known as Vivint, Inc., case. The checks were for \$15,000 and \$40,850 totaling \$55,850.
