**CALL TO ORDER:**

**Chairman, Jack Acre, called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.**

**RECOGNITION OF THE NEWS MEDIA:**

**MINUTES:**

**Chairman Jack Acre asked for a motion to accept the minutes from the last meeting held on September 13, 2006. Mike Vowell so moved. Joey Smith seconded the motion and carried unanimously.**

**HEARINGS:**

**PRO TECH SECURITY, INC. (CI 06-029) Mr. Kevin Bell, Registered Manager, was present with his attorney Jeff Singleton. The Board's attorney, Don Barnes, was present and represented the Board.**

**Mr. Bell and Amy Hancock testified.**

**Joey Smith made a motion to assess a \$500 fine. This motion was seconded by Pat Walsh and carried with one opposed.**

**Joey Smith amended his motion to include a motion to find that Mr. Bell violated the act and assessed a \$500 fine. This motion was seconded by Pat Walsh and carried with one opposed.**

**SECURE VISION COMMUNICATIONS, INC. (CI 06-031) Board Member, Pat Walsh, recused himself from this hearing due to a professional relationship with Mr. Morris.**

**Mr. Ed Morris, Registered Manager, testified.**

**Corporal Briggs stated he would contact the licensing Board in Pennsylvania regarding Universal Atlantic working in Arkansas without a license.**

**Todd Armstrong made a motion to assess a \$500 fine against the company, and to find the company in violation of the Board act. This motion was seconded by Joey Smith and carried unanimously.**

**THE ALARM COMPANY, LLC (CI 06-034) Board Member, Pat Walsh, recused himself from this case due to a professional relationship with Mr. Bob Palazzi. Mr. Bob Palazzi, registered manager, testified. Amy Hancock testified.**

**Joey Smith made a motion to find that the company violated the Board's act and assessed a \$500 fine against the company. This motion was seconded by Mike Vowell and carried unanimously.**

**QUALITY SECURITY SERVICE, INC. (CI 06-047) Mr. Claude Jackson, owner of the company, was present with his attorney Ken Olsen. The Board requested that in the future the company send representatives that are familiar with the company's procedures and employees. The Board is satisfied that the company is in compliance and no fine will be assessed.**

**PRIVATE INVESTIGATORS, INC. (CI 06-056) Mr. Albert Diaz, Registered Manager and Vice-President, testified.**

**Mike Vowell made a motion to find that the company violated the act and assessed a \$500 fine against the company. This motion was seconded by Todd Armstrong and carried unanimously.**

**SECURITAS SECURITY SERVICES USA, INC. (CI 06-057) Mr. Wayne Gibson, Branch Manager, testified. Dale Zimmerman, Registered Manager, testified. Amy Hancock, Board Investigator, testified.**

**Mike Vowell made a motion to find that the company was in violation and assessed a \$1,200 fine. This motion was seconded by Todd Armstrong and carried with one opposed.**

**MARY K. CACERES (BG 06-425) Ms. Caceres testified. Pete Hollinsworth, Registered Manager, testified.**

**Todd Armstrong made a motion to grant her registration. This motion was seconded by Joey Smith and carried unanimously.**

**OLD BUSINESS:**

**Conducting new background checks on applicants for upgrade requests, transfers, and new registrations, when the previous check is 6 months or older:**

**The Board agreed that a background check is needed after 6 months in the above situations.**

**There was discussion about licensed companies subcontracting to un-licensed companies which is a violation of the act.**

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**POLYGRAPH EXAMINER TRAINING:**

**Todd Armstrong addressed the Board, and made a motion requesting the Polygraph seminar be held at AR State Police Headquarters to meet continuing education requirements.**
