CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman, Jack Acre, called the meeting to order at 10:06 a.m.

RECOGNITION OF THE NEWS MEDIA:

Senior Corporal Ricky Briggs, Administrator, confirmed notification of the news media in regard to this meeting.

MINUTES:

Chairman Jack Acre asked for a motion to accept the minutes from the last meeting held on July 12, 2006. Mike Vowell so moved. Roger Pearson seconded the motion and carried unanimously.

HEARINGS:

ACCESS SECURITY GROUP, LLC (CI 06-044) Joseph Holcomb, registered manager of the company, testified and pled guilty to the charge against the company.

Joey Smith made a motion to accept the guilty plea, uphold the \$500 fine assessed against the company, and place the company on probation for 1 year.

The Board also ordered Mr. Holcomb to submit the last 3 months invoices, showing who the company's pays for servicing the alarm systems it monitors.

SMART SOUTHERN HOMES (CI 06-048) Mr. Mike McGibbony, registered manager, withdrew the contest statement on the acknowledgement of charges against the company.

Roger Pearson made a motion to accept the guilty plea, uphold the \$1,900 fine assessed against the company, and place the company on probation for 1 year. This motion was seconded by Mike Vowell and carried unanimously.

DIGITAL SECURITY MONITORING (CI 06-051) Mr. Michael Ross, registered manager testified. Donald and Pamela Horton testified.

Roger Pearson made motion to find the company guilty, and to fine the company \$1,000. This motion was seconded by Mike Vowell and carried unanimously.

SHARON D. HESTER (BG 06-292) Sharon Hester testified. Don Allen, her supervisor, testified.

Roger Pearson made a motion to grant her registration. This motion was seconded by Joey Smith and carried unanimously.

M.T. Starks (BG 06-357) Mr. Starks was not present. Don Allen, his supervisor, testified.

Mike Vowell made a motion to deny his registration. This motion was seconded by Joey Smith and carried unanimously.
